Dr. J. Larry Brown is Executive Director of the Institute on Assets and Social Policy at Brandeis University's Heller School for Social Policy and Management, where he also directs the Center on Hunger and Poverty. Formerly on the faculty of the Harvard School of Public Health, Brown served as chairman of the Physician Task Force on Hunger in America. He is a past board chair of Oxfam America, and served as Assistant Director of Peace Corps/VISTA under President Carter. Dr. Brown is a leading proponent of the idea that an asset policy framework is the only viable way to re-build the nation's social contract for decades to come. He is author of numerous articles in both lay and scientific journals, such as *Scientific America*, *Encyclopedia Britannica*, and *The American Prospect* and has authored several books, including *Living Hungry in America*. Dr. Brown holds the position of Distinguished Scientist, Brandeis University.
